TIMES -

- Year 0 -2 the disco will be held at lunchtime from 12.40pm – 1.15pm – come to school dressed in theme (anything to do with the Jungle)
 - Year 3 -4 will be held from 5.15pm – 6.30pm
 - Year 5 -6 will be held from 6.45pm – 8.00pm

TICKETS - Tickets are required to be purchased prior to the disco. Tickets will need to be shown on the day to gain entry into the disco. Tickets go on sale on Monday 21st, before school outside of Kawakawa 3. They will be for sale on Monday 21st, Tuesday 22nd, Wednesday 23rd & Thursday 24th mornings from 8.10-8.30am.

PRICES -

- Year 0 – 2: \$4 per child - juice, water and popcorn will be provided. Children will be given a glow-stick (no money required at the Disco).
- Year 3 – 6: \$4 per person - juice, lemonade and water will be provided.
- Sweets, chips and glow-sticks will be for sale for 50c-\$1.00. (Night Discos Only)



To ensure the children’s safety all children attending the night disco will be marked off a class list on arrival. No children will be allowed to leave the hall or outside enclosure area during the disco.

PARENT HELP -

- **Help is required to set up the disco, this is done from 1pm on Wednesday 23rd – just turn up (to the old hall) if you can assist.**
- The year 0 -2 disco will be run by the teachers and a couple of parent helpers only (no pre-school children).
- The Year 3 – 4 disco and Year 5 – 6 disco will require the help of 6 parents each on the night. No other parents or siblings will be allowed into the hall until the last dance.
- A room will be made available for those parents who wish to stay at school while the disco is on and tea and coffee will be provided.
- The 6 parents will ensure no children leave the hall until they are collected by their parents, serve the drinks & food and they will also assist with behaviour.
- Any children who do not respond to the parents helping will be removed from the disco and supervised in a room until the end of the disco.
- If you would like to be a parent helper for one of the disco’s please sign up on the board outside the office the week prior – without your support the disco can not operate.
